FINAL JUDGMENT OF DIVORCE

This matter having been heard on _____ before the Honorable Judge Learned Hand, J.S.C., in the presence of Theodore Sliwinski, Esq., attorney for plaintiff, and the defendant having defaulted, and the court having heard and considered the complaint and proofs; and it appearing that the plaintiff and defendant were married to each other; and the plaintiff having been a bonafide resident of this State for more than one year next preceding the commencement of this action, and jurisdiction having been acquired over the defendant pursuant to the Rules governing the courts; and it further appearing that the plaintiff has made out sufficient grounds for divorce against the defendant to be granted a divorce decree therefore agreeable to the Statute of this State, to wit, N.J.S.A. 2A:34-2; and the defendant, having been served with the summons and complaint in the above entitled action;

It is, thereupon, on this _____ day of _____ 2006,

by the Superior Court of New Jersey, Chancery Division, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, and such Court by virtue of the power and authority of this court and the acts of the Legislature in such case made and provided, does hereby order that the plaintiff, and the defendant, be divorced from the bonds of matrimony for the cause of action aforesaid, and the parties, and each of them, be freed and discharged from the obligation thereof; and it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that pursuant to the statute in such case made and provided the marriage between the parties is hereby dissolved; and it is further

ORDERED that the grounds for this divorce shall be on the grounds of extreme cruelty; and it is further

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the defendant shall be permitted to resume her maiden name of Patty Plaintiff; and it is further

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that a copy of the within judgment shall be served upon all parties, within (7) days of its receipt from the court.
